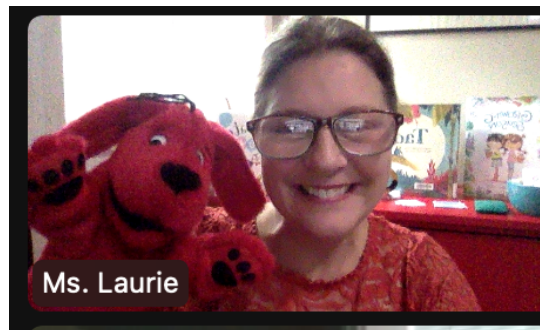
A Children's Studio & Ms. Laurie's Virtual PreK-TK
